



An Athlete Shall:

- Adhere to the Athlete Code of Conduct.
- Maintain high standards of moral and ethical conduct that includes self-control and responsible behavior. An athlete should consider the physical and emotional well-being of others and display courtesy and good manners. An athlete shall not engage in any sexual activity.
- Avoid profane or abusive language and disruptive behavior including behavior that is dangerous to self or others including acts of violence, physical or sexual abuse, or harassment.
- Abide by the rules of competition especially the Official Special Olympics Sports Rules.
- Abstain from transport, storage, and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products and/or illegal substances when participating in any Special Olympics sponsored or sanctioned activities. These activities include, but are not limited to, training/practice sessions and competition events.
- Abstain from all illegal activity.
- Honor the Special Olympics Athlete Oath.
